To apply for this position, applicants must meet the following selection criteria:

- Be an enthusiastic and highly capable classroom teacher able to work cooperatively and collaboratively as part of an energetic and highly capable team
- A sound understanding of the Languages Curriculum, in particular Auslan, and current educational theories and practices
- Offer a differentiated curriculum to cater for children of all abilities along with a desire to help all students achieve their full potential
- Demonstrate excellent classroom management and organisational skills that create supportive and safe environments
- Possess strong ICT skills and the ability to integrate technology in the teaching and learning program.
- Have excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Understand and demonstrate the importance of developing positive relations with children, staff and parents
- Display a high degree of professionalism
- Understand the importance of contributing to the cultural and community life of the school
- Have a sense of humour

Qualifications Required:

- Possess a minimum 4 year tertiary qualification
- Have completed or willing to work towards 'Accreditation to Work in a Catholic School'
