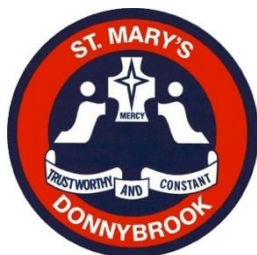


# St Mary's Catholic Primary School, Donnybrook



## Fee Structure 2026

It is essential for the running and improvement of school facilities and resources, as well as the sharing of responsibility between all families, that we receive payment of fees. Fees for 2026 have been revised in accordance with Catholic Education's Low Fee Initiative.

As part of the Low Fee Initiative, the tuition cost includes the following:

- literacy/numeracy books and subscriptions.
- all the stationary students will require throughout the year.
- some of the costs associated with incursions/excursions, sporting events and class consumables (further costs for incursions/excursions may need to be charged).
- swimming lessons, yearbook and a contribution to Year 6 school camp.

Student Insurance is for each child attending St Mary's.

The building levy supports the school in ongoing maintenance and building projects.

The P&F Levy supports the Parents and Friends Committee in driving positive initiatives for our students.

School fees are billed annually. Payment options include:

- a 'one off' payment which is payable within 14 days of billing.
- payments scheduled over a 10-month period (February-November)
- monthly, fortnightly or weekly using the direct debit facility of the Catholic Development Fund (please see the office to set this up) or by arranging direct transfers into the school's NAB account (details will be on the Fees Invoice).

A written commitment will be required from families indicating their preferred payment option, when fees are invoiced in February. Other payment options are available by making an appointment with the principal. Likewise, if you are having difficulty meeting the full fee amounts, please do not hesitate to contact the principal for a confidential meeting to discuss options and alternatives.

If you have a Health Care Card (HCC) or Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) please present this with your written commitment.
